

AVICII CELEBRITY TRIBUTES, TWEETS AND A TRIUMPHANT LEGACY FOR THE EDM TRAILBLAZER

Just a few days after being nominated for the best electronic music album by Billboard, Tim Bergling – better recognised by his stage name of Avicii – passed away while on a trip to Oman (bottom right with a fan in Muscat) at the age of just 28.

Best known for his eclectic mixes and modern twists on

country music, the Swedish DJ rose to fame in 2011 after his single *Levels* soared to the top of charts across the world.

The hit-maker, who was twice nominated for Grammy awards, then went on to collaborate with A-listers including Coldplay's Chris Martin, Madonna, David Guetta and Green Day's Billie Joe Armstrong.

Avicii had announced a break from live tours in 2016, after performing his last show in Dubai, due to ill health and had cancelled a headlining gig at Ultra due to an emergency pancreatic and appendix operation that many attributed to the wild-living lifestyle at the start of his career that kicked off when he was just a teenager.

Fans took to the

streets to celebrate his life with a memorial dance party in his hometown of Stockholm, while celebrities took to Twitter to express their grief over the loss.

Fellow Ibiza-regular Calvin Harris said: "Devastating news about Avicii, a beautiful soul, passionate and extremely talented with so much more to do. My heart goes out to his family. God bless you Tim."



JENNA DEWAN RED CARPET RETURN FOLLOWING SPLIT

She's been keeping a low profile since she announced on social media that she was splitting up with husband Channing Tatum on April 2, but Jenna Dewan took to the red carpet for the first time since her official break-up with a very special gent on her arms – her father, Darryll Dewan.

The *World of Dance* host – who stopped wearing her wedding ring weeks ago – was honoured as the Humanitarian of the Year at the annual St. Jude Children's Research Hospital's Hope & Heritage Gala and stunned on the night in a black embroidered dress (below).

The 37-year-old, who has been

an advocate for the New York institution for years, didn't have to come solo either. Her father stepped up to support his actress daughter and was happy to pose alongside her on her big night, as she beamed, obviously thrilled that he'd joined her.

The twins – who were born prematurely at 32 weeks – ran in memory of their brother Rocky, who their mother Tana sadly lost when she was five months pregnant.

Holly took to Instagram to announce their participation in the race by posting a picture

with her brother from their Gatsby-themed birthday party (above centre), encouraging everyone to donate to the cause.

While waiting at the starting line, Jack was captured placing a sticker on Holly's wrist, which read: "So proud of you Hols my partner in crime and best friend. So proud of you – keep going!"

The twins are following in their big sister Megan's footsteps – she completed the same race in 2017. The 20-year-old said that she was "super proud" of them.

A bumper group of A-list stars will welcome new additions to their families this year – just as the Duchess of Cambridge did last month and Zara Tindall will do in the summer. Here we take a look at seven magnificent leading ladies and model mums-to-be with great expectations in 2018.

RACHEL WEISZ

Actress Rachel Weisz and her James Bond-star husband, 50-year-old Daniel Craig, announced their happy pregnancy news last month. And last week, the radiant 48-year-old star of *The Mummy* and *The Lobster* stepped out in New York with her bump on show.

Already mum to Henry, 11, her son from her long-term relationship with *Black Swan* director Darren Aronofsky, to whom she was engaged, Oscar winner Rachel showcased her blooming figure in a pretty textured red summer dress, which was cinched in just above her tummy.

She was heading to an event at 92Y, a cultural and community centre in the Big Apple, to promote her new movie, the drama *Disobedience*, having revealed the news of her pregnancy in an interview with *The New York Times*.

"Daniel and I are so happy. We're going to have a little human," she told the paper, adding: "We can't wait to meet him or her. It's all such a mystery."

Friends for many years before romance blossomed, Rachel and Daniel – who has a 25-year-old daughter, Ella, from his two-year marriage to actress Fiona Loudon – wed in 2011 in a private ceremony attended by just four guests, including Ella and Henry.



KIRSTEN DUNST

Spider-Man star Kirsten Dunst and her actor beau Jesse Plemons – best known for his roles in *Black Mirror* and *Breaking Bad* – are expecting their first child together.

The mum-to-be announced the exciting news on Instagram, when she shared a stunning picture of her from the 2018 Rodarte photoshoot, dressed in a beautiful floral tulle gown and caressing her blooming baby bump.

Since making the initial announcement, the 35-year-old Hollywood beauty has been laying low

and has only been pictured on social outings or dates with her 30-year-old other half. The actress first opened up about her desire to start a family in an interview with *Marie Claire*, revealing: "I'm at a stage in my life where I'm like, I've been working since I was three. It's time to have babies and chill. I wasn't one of those, 'I need a baby!' people until my goddaughter was born. I love her so much. I put her to bed last night and she woke up and said to her mum, 'Where's Kiki?' I just love that love. That's what I want."

MIRANDA KERR

Miranda Kerr (right) is expecting her first baby with billionaire husband Evan Spiegel any day now.

The model announced she was pregnant in November last year, giving son Flynn, seven – from her first marriage, to actor Orlando Bloom – a younger brother or sister.

And she said Flynn has been eager for her to get pregnant for some time.

Speaking during a TV interview, Miranda, 35, said: "Evan and I had been together for a while, and [Flynn] was like: 'When are we going to have a baby brother or sister?' We were like: 'We've got to get married first.'"

"The day after the wedding, he comes running in, and he's like: 'Mommy, is it in there?' I was like: 'Honey, give it a minute!'"

Mum to 14-year-old Ryder, her son by her former husband, musician Chris Robinson, and Bingham, six, from her relationship with Muse frontman Matt Bellamy, Kate Hudson (above) is expecting her third child – a girl – later this year and it will be her first with boyfriend Danny Fujikawa.

The 39-year-old *Marshall* actress, whose mum is Hollywood star Goldie Hawn, shared the happy news of her pregnancy on Instagram in early April.

“SURPRISE!!! If you’ve wondered why I’ve been so absent on my social channels it’s because I have never been more sick,” she wrote, adding that she had experienced “the most

sick first trimester of all my children”. Revealing that the baby would be a girl, an accompanying video showed Danny and Kate popping balloons that showered pink confetti. “We have been trying to keep this pregnancy under the radar for as long as possible but I’m a poppin now!” Kate wrote in the caption. “And it’s too darn challenging to hide, and frankly hiding is more exhausting than just coming out with it! My kids, Danny, myself and the entire family are crazy excited! A little girl on the way.”

Kate and musician Danny have been dating for around 12 months but have been good friends for nearly 15 years.



LUISANA LOPILATO

Singer Michael Bublé and his wife Luisana Lopilato (above) have recently announced they are expecting their third child.

Michael, 42, revealed the happy news during Canada’s Juno music awards – which he first hosted five years ago when Luisana was expecting their first – telling the audience: “Oops, you did it again! My wife and I are pregnant with our number three.”

It is thought that model and actress Luisana, 30, is around five months pregnant. The baby will be a brother or sister to the couple’s sons, Noah, four, and Elias, two.

The news follows a tough time for the family after Noah was diagnosed with liver cancer aged three. However, he responded well to treatment and reports at Christmas said he was “doing very well”. Both Michael and Luisana stepped away from their careers to care for their son.

Luisana has spoken of having more children, saying: “Being a mother is the best role. I would love to have 20 children but my body wouldn’t be up to it.”

EVA LONGORIA BASTÓN

Positively blooming as she prepares to give birth to her first child – a boy – within weeks, *Desperate Housewives* star Eva Longoria Bastón (right) announced her pregnancy just before Christmas and recently said she was feeling overwhelmed at the prospect of becoming a mother.

“I’m nervous, excited, emotional,” said the actress and activist, 43, who married media mogul José “Pepe” Bastón, 49, two years ago.

The star, who is the youngest of

four girls, also said her whole family will be at the hospital when she gives birth. “They won’t be in the delivery room but they’ll be there,” she said.

This month, Eva told US chat show host Jimmy Kimmel she was struggling with her body as her due date nears.

“Everything’s uncomfortable,” she said. “It’s not just your belly – everything gets bigger. I’ve never seen my thighs so big. And my boobs... they’re in the way of everything. It’s hard.”

HILARIA BALDWIN

Life is about to get a whole lot busier for Hilaria Baldwin and her actor husband Alec, 60, who will soon become parents to four children under five.

The yoga and wellness expert (below), who is already mum to Carmen, four, Rafael, two, and one-year-old Leo, is expecting a boy.

“I didn’t know how much I’d

like it – and I really, really like it. For some reason, right after I deliver a baby I want another one.

“It’s like going down this crazy slide and then you’re like: ‘I want to go again.’ It’s just so invigorating and I had great experiences.”
